What to do in the Rough

Since our sprinkler heads have been replaced I have noticed more rough and thicker rough in on our golf course. This has not been an issue most of this year due to the extreme drought conditions we are experiencing. If you do happen to get in an area where the ball is buried here are a few tips. First and foremost do not try to be superman or woman. Hybrid clubs are a wonderful invention but if a ball is completely buried *they will not advance the ball*. Try to take a club with some loft like an 8 iron, 9iron, or pitching wedge. If the lie is horrendous take your medicine and hit a sand wedge. Place the ball in the middle of your stance and make a very aggressive swing. The last thing you want to do in the rough is make a half hearted golf swing. The key to hitting the ball well out of the rough is to get steeper at impact which in layman's terms means hit down more on the ball. So make practice swings and really give the ground a good thump; make sure the club is hitting the ground somewhere ahead of where the ball would actually be in your stance. A chopping motion is an appropriate feel in the rough to enable this process of thumping the ground hard. Lastly try to swing the club extremely to the left in your follow-through to help hit the ball as cleanly as possible and to help ensure the ball goes in the intended direction. The tendency for the ball in the rough (for righty's) is to go left; this possibility is decreased the more you swing the club to the left directly after impact. Give this a try so it's not so rough out there!

MGA Member - Guest Tournament

The annual Men's Golf Association Member – Guest golf tournament will take place on September 18th- 20th. The three day event kicks off on Friday at 1PM. The format for Friday's play will be a two person scramble. The 10 low net/gross scores and ties will qualify for the shootout scheduled for Saturday afternoon on the back nine. The format for Saturday's play will be a two-person shamble and for Sunday's final round the format will be two-person best ball. The event is open to all MGA Members and their invited guest. Senior Sunrise Golf

On the second Tuesday of each month the club hosts the Senior Sunrise Golf Outing. The event is open to all senior men age 50 and over.
